

How can I allow only authenticated users to join Zoom meetings?

Protect your meetings using "only authenticated users can join meetings" setting. This option allows anyone who has a Zoom account against LUMS email id to access your meeting.

Instructions:

1. Sign into zoom.us with a zoom account e.g., zoom1.sbasse@lums.edu.pk and navigate to the meeting schedule option.
2. Enable "Only authenticated users can join" meetings in the "Meeting options"
3. Select the LUMS authentication profile from drop down menu.

Meeting Options

- Enable join before host
- Mute participants upon entry 
- Enable waiting room
- Only authenticated users can join

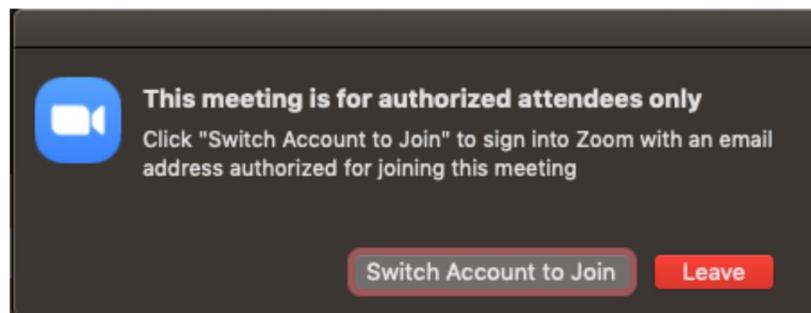
