

FAQs related to Pass/No Credit (P/NC) Policy – MPhil ELM Programme Only
Spring 2021

1. Can I opt for the Pass/No Credit Policy?

Yes, SOE students have the option of converting only one course as PASS including the count of Spring/Fall semester(s) 2020. Moreover, they do not have the option their grades to 'No Credit'.

2. How does this Pass/NC policy work?

In case you opt for a Pass, you will receive credits for the course and there will be NO impact on your CGPA.

However, students enrolled in ELM MPhil programme do not have the option to opt for an NC grade as communicated by the department.

3. When can I convert my grades to Pass/No Credit?

The course grading will be done as usual, but individual students will have the chance to opt to convert their grade to a Pass during the announced dates through an online application, if they wish to avail this option, in consultation with their department.

4. What is the criteria of converting a course to 'Pass'?

Students can convert the grades A+, A, A-, B+, B, B- to 'Pass'.
