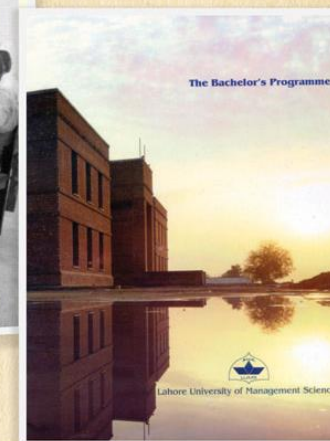

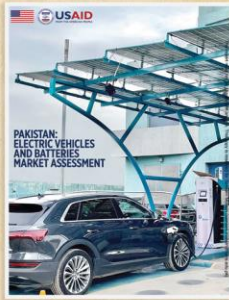

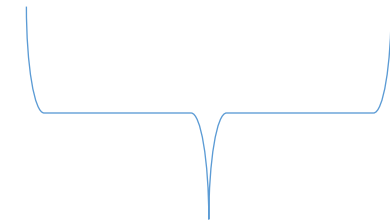

Board of Trustees

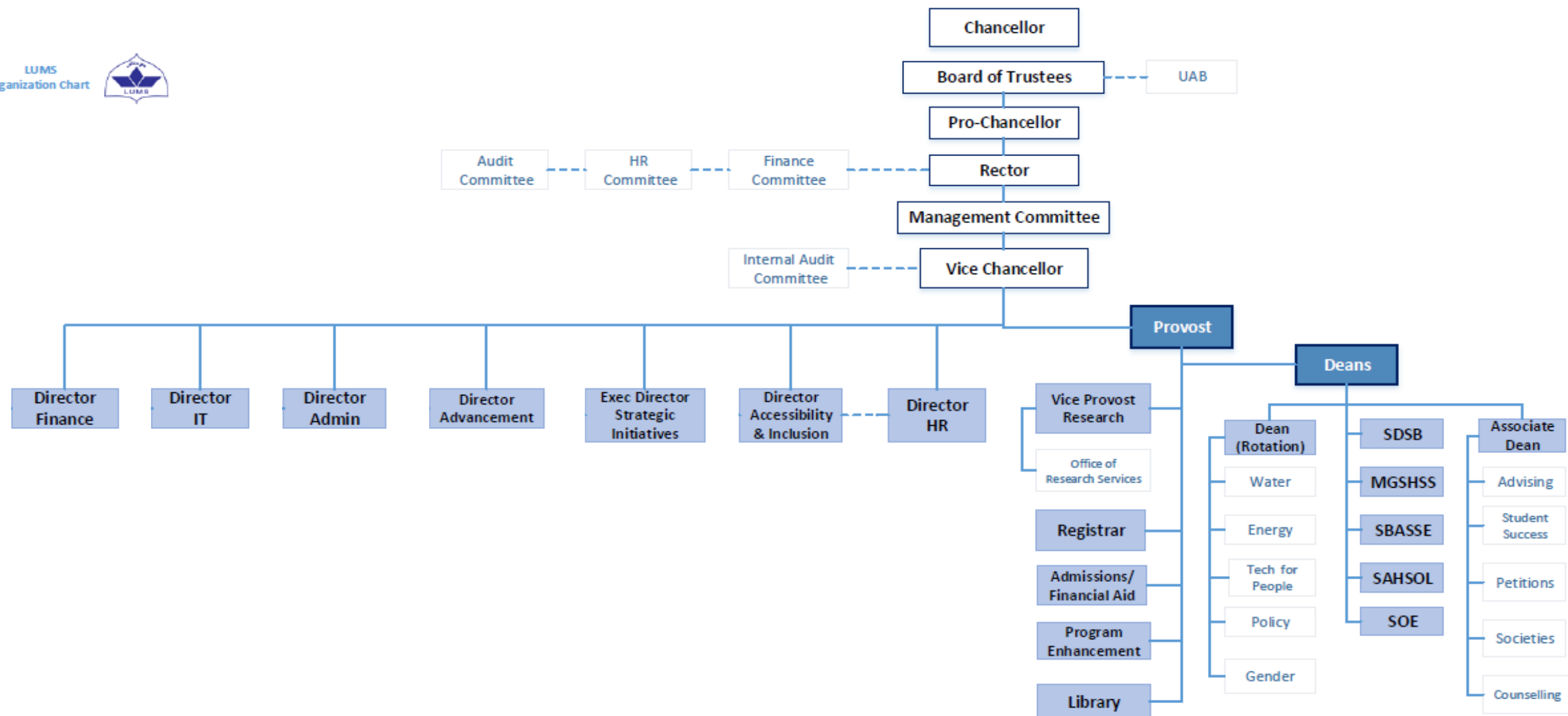
